- Set furnace at 65 degrees
- Turn water off in condos and townhomes when you are not there
- Pick up after your pets
- Large vehicles park between buildings 7 and 8
- Make sure your dogs are not barking when you are not in your unit

Maintenance Minute

With the cooler temperatures, it will soon be time to fire up the furnaces. The Fall furnace PMs will start this month. At this time, they will change the furnace filters and make sure the furnace is working properly. As always, if your furnace is not kicking on or throwing heat contact me immediately.

The sooner I know, the sooner I can have the repairman here. It is a smart idea to routinely check under your sinks and behind your commodes for drips or leaks. Prevention is key to avoiding water damage and insurance claims. Friendly reminder, please do NOT store anything in the furnace closets. It is unsafe. While mentioning that, propane tanks are not allowed to be stored inside any building.

Cold weather means that critters are going to be looking for a warmer place to huddle. Make sure you do not have food laying about to attract them. Also, a mothball in a closet or storage area will help deter them.


