Maintenance Minute

Make sure your cabinet doors are open and that your heat is turned up. Make sure your renters know to let the cabinets doors open at all times during freezing temperatures. Condo owners, it is not a bad idea to make sure your cabinet doors are open as well, and your heat is turned up a bit. Experience has taught us that prevention goes a long way during

these cold snaps.

Fireplace safety. Please make sure you use the utmost safety with regards to fireplaces. If you have a wood burning unit, please make sure you open your flue BEFORE starting your fire. Do not put any hot ashes in the dumpsters, mulch, etc. COLD ashes can go in the dumpster. Please

do not store firewood in the hallways. IMPORTANT REMINDER-Renters are NOT permitted to use any fireplace in any Mountain Villas home.

DO NOT block dumpsters, walkways, bridges, other cars, etc. NO construction material or furniture allowed in the dumpsters.

Shuttle Service at Seven Springs Mountain Villas Resort December 20, 2022 through December 20, 2023

Seven Springs provides shuttle service to the Mountain Villas Association on an annual basis.

Scope of Services

- Standard year-round shuttle service is provided on an on-call basis.
- Service for community members may be requested through Hotel Services by calling the Front Desk (814–352-7777, Ext. 5000).
- During peak holiday periods, shuttle service will increase as needed.
 - During Christmas week <u>December 26, 2022 through January 2nd, 2023</u>, the shuttle will run continuously from 8:00 AM to 2:00 AM.
- This is repeated during both Martin Luther King weekend (<u>starting January 20. 2023</u>) and Presidents' Day weekend (<u>starting February 17. 2023</u>).
- For the 2023 Winter Ski Season –

Starting on Friday, January 6, 2023 the weekend shuttle service will be as follows:

- Fridays Starting at 6:00 PM through Saturday at 2:00 AM
- Saturdays will be continuous from 8:00 AM until Sunday at 2:00 AM
- Sundays will be from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM.
- The Winter Ski Season continuous service, as noted above, will stop on Sunday March 19, 2023. Service will then continue to be provided on an on-call basis.


